

JUNE, 2025 CN JANSEN SPUR CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION BULLETIN

HIGHLIGHTS

- **Contractor remobilization** began in early spring of 2025 and active construction commenced in May 2025.
- Spring runoff and drainage review is underway with affected landowners.
- Skeleton track construction has resumed on the north end of the project, with a focus on completing rail crossings and linear track.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

- The focus of construction in 2025 is to finalize construction activities and get the spur into service.
- There will be fewer trucks on the municipal roads for this season. Expect to see low-speed trains and equipment using the rails to bring in materials for work crews.
- Regular environmental monitoring activities are resuming. Weed monitoring along the Right of Way will be ongoing.
- Rural Municipality representatives are working with CN and the project team to address local concerns around drainage.
- The CN Communication Tower foundation is being constructed and will be a new addition to the skyline in the area.

- Seeding and weed spraying will be taking place to help prevent loose topsoil from spreading and encourage native plant species to grow.
- CN Signals and Communication teams will erect a Communication Tower this summer.
- Final construction activities will help to get the spur fully operational by the fall.
