

BYLAWS 3/2019

WATER & SEWER MANAGEMENT BYLAW

A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE USE AND CONSUMPTION OF WATER FROM THE MUNICIPALITY'S WATERWORKS SYSTEM AND CONTROLLING AND REGULATING THE DISCHARGE OF SEWAGE INTO THE MUNICIPALITY'S SEWAGE SYSTEM.


The Council of the Town of Lanigan in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be cited as "The Water & Sewer Management Bylaw".
2. In this Bylaw, including this section:
 - a) "Municipality" means the Town of Lanigan
 - b) "Clerk" means the Clerk/Administrator of the Municipality
3. Persons who want to be supplied with water from the Municipal system must make application to the Clerk of the Municipality.
4. Each application shall be accompanied by the payment of a water meter deposit as outlined below

5/8" water meter service	\$200.00
3/4" water meter service	\$250.00
5. The water meter deposit shall be refunded upon service being discontinued at the request, by the consumer, provided all water usage charges are paid in full.
6. The Municipality shall have the right to limit the amount of water furnished to any customer, should circumstances seem to warrant such action.
7. No person shall convey, sell, dispose of or give away or permit water to be carried or taken away or use it or supply it for the use or benefit of others.
8.
 - a) No person shall discharge into any drain, sewer, sewage system operated by the Municipality of a harmful matter, substance or thing, whether liquid or solid that would be injurious to health, life or property or that would injure, pollute, block or damage any stream, watercourse, drain, sewer, sewer system or sewage treatment plant.
 - b) The service of any person who contravenes this section of the Bylaw shall be discontinued and a fine may be imposed for breach of the Bylaw as outlined in Section 10.
 - c) That under Section 25(2) of *The Municipalities Act*, Council hereby makes the owner of a parcel of land who is connected to the Municipal sewer main line responsible for the costs of the construction, maintenance, repair and replacement of the portion of the sewer service connection line from the main lines of the system or works to the boundary of the street, road or easement.
 - d) All Buildings with a sanitary sewer service connection to the sewer main shall have a back flow preventative system installed that complies with Saskatchewan Health Regulations and allows for proper venting downstream in accordance with the Plumbing and Drainage Regulations and the National Plumbing Code.
 - e) All new Buildings shall provide for a dual drainage system that will allow water collected in a sump pit to be disposed of as follows:
 - 1) During the period of May 1st to September 30th, the owner shall pump the water directly out of the building, on to the owner's property and or to a street or back lane.
 - 2) During the period of October 1st to April 30th, the owner may pump the water from the sump pit into the sanitary sewer service.

9. When any rate, charge or rent owed by an owner of land or a building is in arrears after December 31st of the year in which it becomes payable, the amount of the rate charge or rent shall be added to and thereby form part of the taxes on the land or buildings of the owner with respect to which the public utility service was provided.
10. Any person who contravenes any portion of this Bylaw for which no other penalty is provided shall be guilty of an offense and liable upon summary conviction to penalties provided under the General Penalty Bylaw of the Municipality.
11. Bylaws 5/2011, 4/2017, 8/2017 are hereby repealed.
12. That this Bylaw shall take effect on the 20th day of May, 2019
