

Public Works Operator Job Opportunity

The Town of Lanigan is looking for the right person to fill one Public Works Operators positions.

The Public Works Operator (PWO) is a dynamic position within the town Public Works Department, responsible for maintenance, repair, and construction of municipal infrastructure, including but not limited to, roads, water, sewage systems and facilities. The PWO will be expected to perform various duties, such as but not limited to, manual labour, general maintenance and repairs, operation of various hand tools and equipment including heavy machinery. The role requires a combination of technical skills, mechanical aptitude, and a commitment to safety and community service. The PWO directly reports to the Director of Public Works.

A high school diploma or equivalent is a minimum requirement, with effective communication skills, both written and verbal. Water and/or wastewater certifications are an asset and desirable. Additional certifications for equipment operation are considered an asset. Proven experience and/or knowledge of public works operations including but not limited to road maintenance, water and sewage maintenance, parks maintenance, facilities maintenance, small tools, and heavy equipment is desirable. Availability to work outside of standard hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays, as required by emergency situations or special projects is necessary.

Your cover letter should include your salary expectations and cite three references. A satisfactory criminal record check is a requirement for the successful candidate.
